

CAMDEN COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS 2011 FIREWORKS DISPLAYS RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

Organizations hosting fireworks displays in a county park must secure and meet the following requirements. All information is due to the Camden County Department of Parks no later than thirty (30) days prior to the event.

1. Obtain from the fireworks company:
 - A. An original Certificate of Insurance naming Camden County Board of Chosen Freeholders and the County of Camden as an additional insured with limits of \$3,000,000 per Occurrence and \$3,000,000 General Aggregate Bodily Injury and Property Damage on both general liability and auto liability policies. The sponsoring agency/municipality should also be named as an additional insured on said policy.
 - B. A Hold Harmless Agreement.
 - C. A Workers' Compensation Certificate covering all persons working on the display. Standard policy should provide for (1) Statutory Coverage for NJ, (2) \$500,000 Employers Liability, (3) Broad Form All-States Endorsement and (4) Policy Waiver of Subrogation Clause required.
2. Prepare and provide a site plan showing:
 - A. Location of crowd
 - B. Designated fireworks area
 - C. Distance between shooting area and crowd
 - D. Shell size
3. Provide evidence that arrangements have been made for post display inspection of the park after the show and at first light the following day to look for unexploded fireworks or potentially dangerous materials.
4. Obtain a Fire Safety Permit from the Camden County Fire Marshal. Notify your local fire department.

A Public Events or Site Use Permit will be issued only after all of these requirements have been met and the Parks Department receives a copy of the Fire Safety Permit issued by the Camden County Fire Marshal.
