Goal:

To teach professionals and non-professionals alike, using the simple technique of "QPR", to recognize the warning signs of a suicide crisis, and how to get the person at risk the assistance they need.

Objectives:

- Recognize someone at risk for suicide
- Demonstrate increased knowledge of intervention skills
- Describe knowledge of referral resources and how to refer someone for help
- To understand the relationship of drug use/abuse and increased risk of suicide
