CRITERIA FOR WORKSHOP PRESENTERS AND VENDORS:

- Publishers and distributors of health related books (Vendors only)
- Youth health education and health promotion programs
- Community based and civic organizations
- Physical fitness organizations
- Organizations or individual businesses that promote well-being and self-improvement

All Workshop Presenters are responsible for any workshop set-up needs, including IT equipment. Screens or white boards are available in the classrooms.

All Vendors responsible for any setup needs. A 6ft table is supplied - a white table cloth can be provided upon request. You must bring extension cords for electric.

All Vendors must commit to remain on site until 1:30 PM. Leaving early may result in forfeiting your spot for the following year.

All Exhibit displays must be broken down and removed off site by 3:15 PM.

CRITERIA FOR SALE OF GOODS AND SERVICES:
