For the Partisan General Election:

- **The first draw will be between the Democratic and Republican parties for Columns 1 and 2.**
- **All independent candidates will be in Column 3.**
- **For the independent candidates, if the position in Column 3 can be predetermined because there is only one candidate/bracket of candidates for that office, their names will not be included in the draw.**
- **If there is more than one candidate/bracket of candidates for an office, there will be a draw for position within Column 3. Bracketed candidates will be drawn by slogan.**

For School Board Elections:

- **All candidates will be in a single school board election column which is apart from the partisan part of the ballot.**
- **If the position in the School Board Column can be predetermined because there is only one candidate/bracket of candidates for that office, their names will not be included in the draw.**
- **If there is more than one candidate/bracket of candidates for an office, there will be a draw for position. Bracketed candidates will be drawn by slogan.**

For Fire District Elections:

- **All candidates will be in a single fire election column which is apart from the partisan part of the ballot.**
- **By statute, all candidates for fire district elections will be listed alphabetically by last name, so there will not be a draw for position.**
