# 2021 General Election Drawing for Ballot Position August 9, 2021 at 3pm

# Via LiveStream

#### For the Partisan General Election:

- The first draw will be between the Democratic and Republican parties for Columns 1 and 2.
- All independent candidates will be in Column 3.
- For the independent candidates, if the position in Column 3 can be predetermined because there is only one candidate/bracket of candidates for that office, their names will not be included in the draw.
- If there is more than one candidate/bracket of candidates for an office, there will be a draw for position within Column 3. Bracketed candidates will be drawn by slogan.

## **For School Board Elections:**

- All candidates will be in a single school board election column which is apart from the partisan part of the ballot.
- If the position in the School Board Column can be predetermined because there is only one candidate/bracket of candidates for that office, their names will not be included in the draw.
- If there is more than one candidate/bracket of candidates for an office, there will be a draw for position. Bracketed candidates will be drawn by slogan.

### **For Fire District Elections:**

- All candidates will be in a single fire election column which is apart from the partisan part of the ballot.
- By statute, all candidates for fire district elections will be listed alphabetically by last name, so there will not be a draw for position.
