All services are provided free by a Registered Nurse, Public Health Nurse or a Medical Social Worker. Services are confidential.

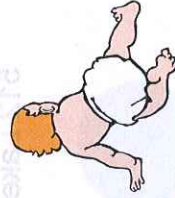
