TO APPLY:

Once you have applied for a Mail-In Ballot;

A. You can Vote by Mail in the next election or for all future elections on one application.

B. Simply complete a Vote by Mail application, which can be obtained from the Camden County Clerk's Office, County Libraries or your local municipal building.
