TIMBER CREEK PARK

Timber Creek is a 128 acre park located in Lindenwold and Gloucester Township and is bounded by Chews Landing Road and Somerdale Road. Formerly a horse farm and still locally known as "Slim's Ranch," Timber Creek Park was acquired through open space funding in 2003.

An extensive network of paved and natural trails explore mowed and fallow fields and streamside woodlands where resident and migrant wildlife is abundant. This park is bounded to the north by Timber Creek and has a beautiful pond area with old visible decking, forested trails, small streams and ravines.

The park includes a playground, a small amphitheater, restrooms, pavilions, and a 9 acre fenced-in dog park. The wooded dog park includes trails, a small lake, and a dog water fountain.
