Summary of Work Completed Week of November 30, 2019

Lexa Concrete (Lexa) continued with demolition of existing concrete and replacement with new concrete sidewalk, curb, and curb ramps. Maintenance and Protection of Traffic (MPT) is set up before each work day and taken down at the end of each work shift. Police Uniform Law Enforcement Officers are additionally utilized for traffic control. An onsite progress meeting was held on November 25, 2019 to review all project related activities.

Anticipated Work for Week of December 7, 2019

Lexa will continue with the removal and replacement of concrete curb, sidewalk, driveways, and curb ramps as specified in the plans along Chapel Avenue. The contractor will also continue with the installation of the storm sewer system. Daily traffic control will continue to be implemented for the duration of the project.
