Project SAVE is a program launched by the Camden County Freeholder Board and the Camden County Addiction Awareness Task Force to continue the fight against addiction.

Municipalities all over Camden County joined the effort by placing Certified Drug and Alcohol Counselors in Municipal Courts. This bridges the gap between those arrested for substance-abuse-related-charges and treatment.

The Project SAVE Advocate will work with the Municipal Courts and Prosecutors to connect defendants suffering from addiction and their family members, to available resources and treatment options.

Project SAVE is a voluntary program and is available regardless of ability to pay for services.
