- Installation of concrete sidewalk, curb, reinforced driveways, and curb ramps along Chapel Avenue
- Installation of traffic light foundations, junction boxes, rigid metallic conduit, and traffic signal elements at the intersection of Chapel Avenue and Tower of Windsor Drive

Summary of Work Completed Week of February 29, 2020

Lexa Concrete (Lexa) continued with demolition of existing concrete and replacement with new concrete sidewalk, curb, reinforced driveways, and curb ramps. Lexa's subcontractor Berenato installed foundations, junction boxes, rigid metallic conduit, and traffic signal elements at the intersection of Chapel Avenue and Tower of Windsor Drive. Maintenance and Protection of Traffic (MPT) is set up before each work day and taken down at the end of each work shift. Police Uniform Law Enforcement Officers are additionally utilized for traffic control.

Anticipated Work for Week of March 7, 2020

Lexa will continue with the removal and replacement of concrete curb, sidewalk, driveways, and curb ramps as specified in the plans along Chapel Avenue. Installation of RMC and electrical work will continue throughout the winter. Daily traffic control will continue to be implemented for the duration of the project. An onsite progress meeting will be held on March 4, 2020 to review all project related activities.
