Work Completed this Report Cycle:

This summarizes progress from June 29th through July 3rd, 2020.

- Monday, the concrete crew poured concrete for the gutter along Jarvis Road between stations 122+90R and 124+25R. They spent the rest of the day setting forms for curb and flatwork at the north corner of Mary Ellen Lane. Tuesday they poured concrete for the curb and sidewalk at Mary Ellen Lane and set forms for vertical curb along the left side of Jarvis Road from Dresden Court heading north. Wednesday they poured concrete for the curb between stations 129+75L and 132+35L. Thursday they poured concrete for the apron at 1465 Jarvis Road, the monolithic curb/gutter by inlet D-58 and the access ramp and additional sidewalk at Mary Ellen Lane.
- Monday was the first day on site for the road crew. They began the full depth reclamation
 of Jarvis Road between stations 91+47R and 102+50R. Tuesday they continued with the
 reclamation on the left side of Jarvis between stations 91+47L and 104+00L. Wednesday
 they continued with the reclamation on the right side of Jarvis Road between stations
 102+50R and 115+00R. Thursday they continued with the reclamation on the left side of
 Jarvis Road between stations 104+00L and 115+00L.
- Friday there was no activity on site as the contractor observed the Independence Day holiday.



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Changes to the Initial Contract items:

• No change orders to the Contract to Date, but Work Directives #1 and #2 have been authorized to resolve utility conflicts with negligible impacts to the overall construction cost.

Project Schedule:

- The initial date for Substantial Completion was Saturday, April 25, 2020 and the date of Final Completion was Monday, May 25, 2020. However, since the winter shutdown was implemented, the dates have been adjusted accordingly. The amended Notice To Proceed issued by the County Engineer on April 1, 2020 delineates the project completion dates as Friday, August 28, 2020 for Substantial Completion and Sunday, September 27, 2020 for Final Completion.
