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## RESOLUTION # 31 OF 2019

*Whereas* according to N.J.S.A 54:4-52, the county tax administrator calculates the tax rates when all the applicable budgets for that municipality are certified and transmitted to the board. However, the Board shall take appropriate action to certify the general tax rate for each municipality;

*Whereas* the county tax administrator has calculated tax rates on all certified budgets that have been transmitted to the board;

*Whereas* the Borough of Collingswood by referendum through the November 2019 election through separate question has increased the amount to be raised by taxation;

*Whereas* the Borough of Collingswood received a supplemental certified increase to the budget after prior certification; and

*Whereas* a "revised" certified A4F form has been re-submitted by the School Board of Collingswood to the Camden County Board of Taxation and that amount differs from the prior certification now therefore, be it

*Resolved*, that the Camden County Board of Taxation does hereby certify the supplemental school tax rate for the Borough of Collingswood to be .022 per hundred of assessed value. The net valuation taxable used in the calculation is 1,066,855,200. The supplemental amount to be raised is \$225,000.00 and shall be collected in the first and second quarters of the 2020 tax year. The supplemental tax rate has been so calculated by the tax administrator and provided to the tax collector, chief financial officer and tax assessor for the municipality.
