Over 2200 individuals lost their lives in Camden County from 2010-2021. This discussion will focus on where we are now, what the facts are and what is being done to combat it.

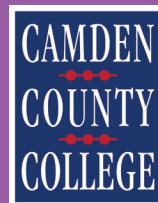
