

BOOSTER ELIGIBILITY



Vaccine Received	Who	When	Booster Options
Pfizer	Age 65 or older Age 18 – 64 (with underlying health conditions whose job or living circumstances put them at risk for exposure to COVID-19)	6 months after second dose	Pfizer, J & J or Moderna (Half-Dose)
Moderna	Age 65 or older Age 18 – 64 (with underlying health conditions whose job or living circumstances put them at risk for exposure to COVID-19)	6 months after second dose	Pfizer, J & J or Moderna (Half-Dose)
Johnson & Johnson	Age 18+	2 months after single dose	Pfizer, J & J or Moderna (Half-Dose)

Note: The Moderna single booster dose is half of the dose administered for a primary series dose. CDC recommends that people who are moderately to severely immunocompromised (have a weakened immune system) receive a **third dose of an mRNA COVID-19 Vaccine** (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna); those who are in active cancer treatment, received an organ or stem cell transplant, taking high-dose corticosteroids, or have HIV infection.
