Local Covid 19 exposures are currently at a **high level**.

**Masks are required inside CCCollege.** Camp sessions will be held outside, but high temperatures may cause us to plan inside. Social distancing will be practiced, but sometimes its difficult to do. If your camper is not vaccinated, immunocompromised or in the high risk category, the CDC strongly recommends wearing a properly well fitted mask, inside and outside, in large groups of people and if social distancing cannot be maintained.

\*Please be aware high levels of Covid 19 may cause us to alter or delay camp in an effort to keep everyone safe. Please read The Daily Camp Guide that was sent in your welcome packet.

\*All Campers/Parents/Guardians are required to complete a **Waiver/Release Form**(in welcome packet).This form acknowledges voluntary attendance and lets us know who is responsible to pick up your camper at the bus or the college, which also includes picking up a sick camper.

This form must be in the office before camp begins. No exceptions!

**Saftey and Security**

The College Public Saftey Department and Camp Sunny Side operate daily in the same building and have access to 24 hour EMT services. Additionally, CPR and First Aid training is provided for all camp staff . All health concerns and emergency situations are inmmediately directed to the Public Saftey Office. The EMT will access the situation and make the necessary determination as to the necessary treatment. All necessary contact phone numbers are provided below for the Camp Sunny Side office and Public Saftey Department.

**Transportation** will operate based on current Covid exposure levels and may be altered or delayed. **Masks** are required on the bus.

The times listed below may change and you may be responsible to transport your child.

Please advise the Bus Counselor and Camp Director if someone other than the designated person will be picking up your camper, or changing pick up or drop off locations. Also, please notify us if a camper will be absent from camp. The Camp Staff must know of any changes. You will be given a contact number for the Bus Counselor prior to the start of camp.
