Veterans Medal Awards

The Camden County Commissioners commemorate our service members for their achievements and dedication through year-round recognition medals.



Medals include:

1. Korean War Service Medal

Awarded to Veterans who served on Active Duty anywhere in the world during the Korean War between June 25, 1950 and January 31, 1955. Family members are also entitled to receive this medal posthumously.

2. Vietnam Service Medal

Awarded to Veterans who served on Active Duty anywhere in the world during the Vietnam war between November 1, 1955 and May 15, 1975. Family members are also entitled to receive this medal posthumously.

3. War On Terror Service Medal

Awarded to Veterans who served during the War on Terror and First Responders of the recovery of the 9 / 11 attacks between September 11, 2001 and May 31, 2002.

4. Military Service Medal

Awarded to all honorably discharged veterans who are current residents of Camden County.
