# CAMDEN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS CAUCUS MEETING MARCH 14, 2023 6th FLOOR CONFERENCE ROOM 520 MARKET STREET, CAMDEN, NJ 08102

Director Cappelli called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m. and the following Commissioners answered to their name:

Director Cappelli said good afternoon. This meeting has been properly advertised in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act. The Director asked everyone to stand for a moment of silence to be followed by the Pledge of Allegiance which was led by Commissioner Young.

The Director then called upon each Commissioner individually to present his or her Resolutions.

## Resolutions and discussion of proposed Resolutions by or on behalf of Commissioner Dyer

Commissioner Dyer read Resolutions 1 through 10 into the record and they were approved to be placed on the Agenda for adoption.

Resolution amending Resolution No. 86, adopted June 17, 2021 ratifying the submission of a Grant Application, by the County of Camden (Office of Community Development) to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, for the FY 2021 Consolidated Strategy and Action Plan, to include HOME-ARP Funds in the amount of \$4,108,852.00.
