

### **BACKGROUND**

WHEREAS, The Camden County Improvement Authority ("Authority") has been duly created by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners ("Board") of the County of Camden, New Jersey ("County") as a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey ("State") pursuant to and in accordance with the county improvement authorities law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1960 of the State, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto (N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq.) ("Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority is authorized by the Act (N.J.S.A. 40:37A-54(1)), subject to approval of the Local Finance Board in the Department of Community Affairs ("Local Finance Board"), to finance the planning, design, acquisition, construction, improvement, renovation, installation, maintenance and operation of facilities or any other type of real or personal property within the County for a corporation organized as a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State, except those facilities or any other type of real or personal property which can be financed pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 26:2I-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Home Port Alliance for the USS New Jersey, Inc., a New Jersey nonprofit corporation ("Home Port Alliance"), owns and operates the U.S.S. New Jersey, a decommissioned Unites States Naval warship ("Battleship"), as a museum and memorial; and

WHEREAS, the Battleship, an Iowa-class battleship commissioned for service by the United States Navy from 1943 through 1991, is currently moored on the Delaware River in the City of Camden, New Jersey, having served as a museum ship since October 15, 2001; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Navy's guidelines for inactive ships require dry-docking for periodic maintenance and repair once every 20 years; and

WHEREAS, the Battleship has not been dry-docked since 1991, when it was formally decommissioned by the United States Navy and is in need of critical maintenance, repair and improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has received an application for tax-exempt financing from Home Port Alliance seeking financial assistance to pay for a portion of the costs associated with the dry-docking of the Battleship and thereupon the completion of various repairs, capital improvements and renovations to the Battleship ("Dry-Docking Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has reviewed the application and has determined to provide financing to pay for: (i) a portion of the costs Dry-Docking Project; (ii) the funding capitalized interest on the hereinafter defined Bonds for approximately 12 months (if determined to be necessary); (iii) the funding a debt service reserve fund (if determined to be necessary); and (iv) a

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portion of the costs of issuance of the Bonds (the purposes described in clauses (i) through (iv) hereof are hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in furtherance thereof, the Authority has determined to issue and sell up to \$3,250,000 aggregate principal amount of its County-Guaranteed Revenue Bonds (Home Port Alliance Project), Series 2024 ("Bonds") to finance the costs of the Project; and

WHEREAS, as security for the repayment of the Bonds, Home Port Alliance, pursuant to and in accordance with a Bond Agreement to be executed by and among the Authority, Home Port Alliance and the purchaser of the Bonds (TD Bank, National Association) ("Bond Agreement"), will be obligated to make loan payments ("Loan Payments"), which will be used by the Authority to pay principal of and interest on the Bonds under the Bond Agreement; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the economic importance of Project and to induce the prospective purchasers of the Bonds to purchase the same and provide additional security to the holders thereof, the County has heretofore determined, in accordance with a resolution duly and finally adopted by the Board, pursuant to Section 37 of the Act (N.J.S.A. 40:37A-80), to unconditionally and irrevocably guaranty the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the Bonds, when due, by the adoption of a guaranty resolution ("County Guaranty"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority has applied to the Local Finance Board pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 40A:5A-6 and *N.J.S.A.* 40:37A-80, for positive findings for the undertaking and completion of the Project, the issuance of the Bonds to finance the costs thereof and for approval for the provision of the County Guaranty by the County and has received the requisite positive findings and approval from the Local Finance Board on October 11, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has informed the County: (i) that the approval of the Local Finance Board with respect to the issuance of the Bonds and the financing of the Project has been received by the Authority; (ii) that Home Port Alliance has represented to the Authority that it is a corporation organized for one or more purposes set forth in subsection (a) of N.J.S.A. 14A:2-1 and has been determined to be an organization exempt from federal income taxation pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"); and (iii) that the Project is not one which can be financed pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 26:2I-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority will issue the Bonds pursuant to the Act, a Bond Resolution adopted by the Authority on October 12, 2023 ("Bond Resolution") and the Bond Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Bonds shall be special, limited obligations of the Authority, payable solely from and secured by the Collateral (as defined in the Bond Agreement), which shall include: (i) a pledge of all payments to be made by the Borrower under the Bond Agreement; (ii) a pledge of the payments by the County under the County Guaranty; and (iii) certain funds and accounts created under the Bond Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the repayment obligations of Home Port Alliance under the Bond Agreement are secured by the general credit of Home Port Alliance; and

WHEREAS, the Authority now seeks from the Board approval in order to effectuate the financing of the Project by way of the issuance of the Bonds pursuant to and in accordance with Section 147(f) of the Code and N.J.S.A. 40:37A-56.
