#### POLICY

An employee who is a member of the Reserves or National Guard will be granted a leave of absence in accordance with law or regulation.

#### **PROCEDURE**

- A. In accordance with N.J.A.C. 4A:6-1.11, County employees who are in the National Guard or Reserves shall be granted time off for military service.
- B. In order to qualify for a leave of absence with pay, the duty ordered must be some form of active-duty military service as defined in N.J.A.C. 4A:6-1.11. Absences for any form of "inactive duty training" (IDT i.e "drill", Battle Assembly, UTA/MUTA) is eligible for excusal but not eligible for paid military leave.
- C. For service in the New Jersey Army or New Jersey Air National Guard, Permanent employees, or those employees with at least one year of full-time Temporary service, are entitled to paid military leave, not to exceed 90 workdays in the aggregate per calendar year, for workdays missed for federal active-duty service. Paid Military Leave for "State Active Duty" service under the authority of New Jersey statutes is unlimited.
- D. For service in the Reserves or the National Guard of States other than New Jersey, Permanent employees, or those employees with at least one year of full-time Temporary service, are entitled to paid military leave, not to exceed 30 workdays in the aggregate per calendar year for federal active-duty service. There is no entitlement to paid military leave for State Active Duty in the service of a State other than New Jersey.
- A County employee requesting a leave of absence with differential pay must submit a copy of his/her active-duty military order. Such orders are subject to verification by the Personnel Division. When an employee is unable to obtain the supporting active-duty order before the duty period commences s/he may submit the resulting military "Leave & Earnings Statement" (LES) reflecting the performance of eligible duty within 30 days of the commencement of leave and when there is a change to such leave in basicapay.
- F At the discretion of the employee vacation, personal, compatine or floating holiday may be used in lieu of a leave of absence <u>without pay</u>

#### POLICY

For purposes of the military operations starting September 11, 2001, employees entering active duty (not active duty for training) will be granted full pay for the first 90 calendar days of continuous active-duty service. This does not supersede the statutory entitlement to 90 work days of paid military leave per calendar year for those eligible employees serving in the New Jersey Army or Air National Guard. Similarly, this does not supersede the 30 work days of paid military leave for those eligible employees serving in the Reserves or National Guard of other states. After exhaustion of the calendar year balance of Paid military leave the County will pay the difference, if any, between the County toll pay and the military gross basic pay. Paid military leave would resume on January 1st with the renewed balance of 30 or 90 workdays for the subsequent calendar year.

#### **PROCEDURE**

- A. Notice shall be given of an obligation or an intention to perform services in the uniformed services. The notice shall be provided to the employer as soon as practicable. Failure to provide notice may result in the denial of protection of the USERRA or denial of benefits/compensation under this policy. The County may, at its discretion, contact the employee's reporting military branch to verify an employee's Order or to obtain additional information regarding the employee's military status. Further, the County may request supplemental information from the employee regarding the military leave or any terms, conditions, benefits, or compensation related to that leave.
- B. Employees are required to provide advance notice of upcoming military duty, either orally or in writing, unless precluded by military necessity. Employees on military duty who desire paid military leave are required to submit their active-duty orders and LES (leave earning statements) or pay stubs to Human Resources and their Department head.
- C. Employees on military leave (or family members) are required to immediately notify Human Resources and their Department Head of any changes in military status, pay, benefits and/or length or duration of military service. Failure to do so may result in the denial of protection of the USERRA or denial, reduction, modification, or reimbursement of the employee's benefits/compensation under this policy.

#### PAY AND BENEFITS

A. Although health benefits coverage can continue for employees who are absent for military duty, it may not be in their interest to do so. This is particularly the case if there is a cost to the employee for continuing the coverage. Employees with single coverage will have their full medical needs met by the military. Family members could possibly have their needs met by the military or other coverage. Therefore, employees may waive their county-provided health benefits coverage in case

they do not need the coverage while the employee is on military duty. If not expressly waived, that coverage will be continued while the employee is on military duty. If coverage is not waived and is continued, the employee will be responsible for normal employee contributions for this coverage. These contributions will be deducted from any differential pay provided. If there is no differential pay or if it is insufficient to cover the health benefits contributions, the employee contributions will be collected from the employee upon return from military duty.

- B. For the first 90 calendar days (90 work days in any calendar year for those employees serving in the New Jersey Army or Air National Guard), employees on active-duty military leave shall receive full pay [County full pay is defined as pay that is pensionable.]
- C. For service in the New Jersey Army or New Jersey Air National Guard, Permanent employees, or those employees with at least one year of full-time Temporary service, are entitled to paid military leave, not to exceed 90 workdays in the aggregate per calendar year, for workdays missed for federal, active-duty service. Paid Military Leave for "State Active Duty" service under the authority of New Jersey statutes is unlimited.
- D. For service in the Reserves or the National Guard of States other than New Jersey, Permanent employees, or those employees with at least one year of full-time Temporary service, are entitled to paid military leave, not to exceed 30 workdays in the aggregate per calendar year for federal active-duty service. There is no entitlement to paid military leave for State Active Duty in the service of a State other than New Jersey.
- En Subsequent to the first 90 calendar days (90 work days in any calendar year for those employees serving in the NJ Army or Air National Guard), employees will receive the difference, if any, between the County full pay and the military gross basic pay for the duration of active military duty, consistent with the provisions of this policy. Each year on January 1st the employee will receive a renewed balance of 30 or 90 paid military leave workdays for the new calendar year. The employee will be entitled to full pay until that balance is exhausted and then may resume receipt of the difference between County full pay and military gross basic pay.
- F. It is the responsibility of the employee to stop or modify all voluntary deductions (deferred compensation, additional life and disability insurance, etc.) during this period. The County will not assume any responsibility in the payment of any voluntary deductions.
- G. If pension back deductions, pension arrears, and pension loan payments are not met from differential pay, their collection should be automatically resumed when the employee returns to employment. If the differential pay is insufficient to cover regular pension deductions in effect at the time of activation, the employer will pay the deductions for an employee's regular pension contribution and contributory group life insurance and accrue that debt until the employee returns to work.
- H. All steps and increments to County full pay will be given to employees on active-duty military leave at the time and at the rate that the employees would normally be due them.
- I. Time off will continue to accrue, while in a paid military leave or differential pay status, to the

extent allowed by the employee's respective bargaining agreement, practice and/or regulation. In no event, however, will an employee be permitted to sell any time back to the County while on leave.

J. The County is obliged to and will follow all the provisions of Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Act of 1994 (USERRA), New Jersey statutes in Title 38 and 38A, and the Civil Service rules at N.J.A.C. 4A:6-1.11.

#### POLICY

It is the policy of the County of Camden that classified employees be disciplined appropriately for infractions pursuant to this Policy.

#### PROCEDURE

- A. When a permanent employee has been absent from duty for five consecutive business days without notice and approval, such employee shall be notified by the appointing authority on form CS-31A of his/her voluntary resignation with notice and opportunity for a hearing.
- B. In any case where a permanent employee in the classified service as defined in Title 11 of the Civil Service regulations of the State of New Jersey is subject to major disciplinary action (N.J.A.C. 4A:2-2.3) by the County of suspension or fine for a period of more than five (5) days at one time or receives suspensions or fines more than three (3) times or for an aggregate of more than fifteen (15) days in one calendar year or is demoted or is removed from his/her position, he/she shall be issued a Preliminary Notice of Disciplinary Action (CS-31A) which will set forth the charges, the specifications, the penalty sought and the hearing date and time. The employee representative shall have the right to represent any employee, but individual employees shall have the right to elect to represent themselves or obtain Counsel.
- C. The Hearing Officer shall render a decision approximately twenty (20) days after the hearing. Copies of the Hearing Officer's report will be served promptly on all parties to the proceedings.
- D. The Division of Human Resources may implement the Hearing Officer's decision by sending a CS-31B to all parties concerned. The employee shall have the right to appeal the Hearing Officer's decision reflected on the CS-31B to the Merit System Board pursuant to N.J.A.C. 4A:2-2.8 within twenty (20) days after receipt of the Final Notice of Disciplinary Action. A copy of said appeal must be served on the Division of Human Resources.
- E. A Notice of Minor Disciplinary Action (CS-379) must be served by the Department on any employee who has received any of the following penalties:
- F. Suspension of five days or less;
- G. Fine (amount equal to five (5) days pay or less).

Copies of this notice must be sent to the employee, employee representative, and the New Jersey Department of Personnel. Documentation shall be placed in the employee's file.

- H. A County employee not in the classified service appointed by resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Camden County and serving at the pleasure of said Board is excluded from the procedures set forth herein.
- I. Periods of suspension without pay shall have annual sick, vacation, personal accruals, etc., credits reduced for the duration of such suspensions on a prorated basis for every full month or 50% of the month.
- Periods of suspension shall not be included in calculating years of service with the County of Camden.

  Periods of suspensions of less than thirty days shall be added together, and every thirty-day increment calculated shall not be included in the calculating of years of service.
