

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

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Following Construction Activities took place during above period:

Construction Activities:

Traffic Control:

- 1. Variable Message Sign at the Zulker Avenue intersection is in place and operational.
- 2. Traffic control, channeling devices and detour signs are in place and in good condition. No issues.
- 3. Traffic is moving safely through the detour. No accidents or incidents reported.
- 4. Berlin Township and Boro police requested that the County close traffic in both directions through the project limits. As a result, the Haddon Avenue bridge over the A.C. Transit rail line will be closed for the duration of the project.

Bridge Rehabilitation Work:

- 1. South State, Inc. continues to work on the reconstruction of the top of the bridge deck.
- 2. The bridge deck was sounded and marked-out for concrete areas in need of removal and replacement.
- 3. Workers saw-cut around the periphery of the marked-out areas and continued chipping out the deteriorated concrete.
- 4. After completion, each open patch was cleaned out with hand tools and compressed air. Broken and/or corroded reinforcing bars were replaced with new, and the remaining original rebar were retied. The open patches were then coated with a spray-on concrete bonding agent.
- 5. Concrete was poured, hand finished, and the fresh concrete was coated with a spray-on liquid curing compound. This work is substantially complete and is expected to be fully complete in the next week or two.
- 6. Workers completed demolition of the south abutment deck joint. Carpenters formed the new joint and concrete was poured and finished.
- 7. Workers completed removal of deteriorated concrete from the west curbs and a portion of the east side curb. Carpenters installed formwork for the new curb sections and concrete was poured and finished. The remaining deteriorated sections are expected to be replaced in the next week or two.
- 8. Sub-Contractor, M-Painting began work on 4-23. They mobilized and began assembly and installation of the pollution control system prior to starting work. The enclosure and dust filter/collection systems were completed, the blasting and painting operation began on Friday, (4-26).

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Contractor's Two Week Look Ahead:

- 1. Complete the deck and curb patch work during the week of 4-29.
- 2. Continue to work on the south abutment deck joint. Strip the formwork and install the new elastomeric seal.
- 3. Continue to work on the bridge deck and sidewalk joints. Continue with the reconstruction of the center pier and north abutment deck joints. That work includes demolition of the existing deteriorated joints and adjacent deck concrete, installing the new deck joint steel (center pier) and forming for the concrete north abutment deck joint. Strip formwork and install the new elastomeric seals.
- **4.** Begin the commercial blast cleaning and re-painting of the roadway steel girders during the week of 4-22. Containment and disposal items are included in this work.
